- 1. 18 ticks from bronze and silver Trix
- 2. Have attended at least 4 club coaching sessions within 2 years
- 3.Ride under a limbo pole 5cm higher than the highest part of the bike
- 3.Bunny hop over an obstacle at least 15cm high
- 4.Track stand of at least 20s
- 5.Remove and replace front and rear wheel including necessary readjustments
- 6. Repair a puncture in a tyre on a wheel
- 7.One lap of the pond in under 50s
- 8. Compete in 2 Notts & Derby Cyclo cross events within 2 consecutive years
- 9. Compete in 4 BSCA events within 2 consecutive years
- 10. Have attended at least 4 clubnights within 2 years 11.25 laps of the pond in under 30 minutes or 5 miles of the Darley Moor circuit in under 30 minutes
